The unique three-part construction of Londeck and Londeck Sierra's 80 mil. thick sheets features a middle layer that provides cushioning for foot traffic, and its exposed PVC wear layer preserves color, strength and resiliency year after year. Its bottom layer, which is molded to the backing cloth, provides stabilization. Properly installed, Lonseal's exterior surfaces are a barrier for moisture, repelling water and bacterial build-up. Its textured surface exceeds ADA standards for slip-resistance on a level surface, yet is easy to clean and maintain.

Backed by a 15-year warranty, Londeck and Londeck Sierra are part of Lonseal's GreenVinyl™ program, containing more than 35 percent pre-consumer recycled content and Londeck and Londeck Sierra can contribute to LEED® accreditation.
